## PARKING LOTS - PAID

The closest parking to our Festival box office and most venues is the centrally located public lot at **MacMillan Pier**, near where the ferries and buses arrive.

Right next to that is a lot at the **Provincetown Marina**, which is closest to the Wharf House and most other venues.

### OTHER OPTIONS:

There is also a large public parking lot off of Bradford St at **Prince St** (right behind the school, at the top of the hill).

There is also a large lot at the **Provincetown Monument**, which is close to the center of town. Access it from Winslow Street.

Metered lots are located at **Johnson St** near the center of town, and on **Shankpainter Rd, Tremont St.**, and **Commercial St.**, in the West End.

## FREE PARKING

The **Provincetown Theater** and **The Provincetown Inn** have parking lots for your use **while you are seeing the performance**. However, you'll need to pick up your tickets at the Box Office, which is close to the center of town, and just a couple minutes' walk from MacMillan Pier.

### STREET PARKING:

In late September, parking is more plentiful on side streets than it is during the height of summer. Still, there is **no street parking** on Commercial Street, between Pearl and Winthrop Streets.

Street parking is permitted on most of **Bradford Street**, except where marked.
